Re: Favors Provided to Connie Vargovich

Mr. Lipske,

This letter concerns your ongoing favoritism toward Connie Vargovich and your actions and inaction intended to protect her from accountability for her many illegal behaviors, and specifically now in regards to her most recent drunk driving charge improperly charged by you as a first offense, which you then had dismissed. First of all, as you well know, it was not her first offense.
