Persons with information continue coming forward with information, thousands of people are following my case, and one of my prayers recently was answered when the University of Wisconsin Law School Innocence Project took my case. So now, for the first time in twelve years, I am hopeful and am convinced that this nightmare will soon be resolved and those responsible for this charade and perversion of justice will be held accountable in the end.

The incompetence, corruption, and cruelty shown by Connie, Judge Madden, DA Lipske and Sheriff Bruneau is simply astounding. What very strange people. And there still are several police officers, and others, who we now know have information but who have not yet come forward, because their names have come up from the lips of witnesses. If they think silence is 'loyalty' to their coworkers and friends, they should think again because, given the circumstances of this case, concealing any information or refusing to disclose it makes them part of the problem and personally involved in the crimes, corruption, and infliction of suffering. I strongly urge them to tell us all that they know.

All of Connie's friends know she falsely accused me; as does the judge, DA, and sheriff, her family, and our entire community also know. And still I sit in prison. Isn't it amazing that they sent me to prison on the pointing of one false accuser's finger, yet now that there is a mountain of evidence proving I was falsely accused, which evidence the jury never saw, these same officials now hide their heads in the sand. These people, who abuse their authority and happily railroaded me into prison on **LIES**, now choose to do nothing with established **FACTS** and **TRUTH**. Apparently they prefer lies, which is why they resort to lying so frequently. They all know that I am innocent, but do nothing.
