There is no reason to be afraid of them, and the more people who they hear from regarding this mess, the sooner they will finally do what they know is right by letting me go home. Your opinions can help bring this nightmare to an end.

People often ask me if I 'hate' Connie, the judge, DA, and sheriff. This would seem to be an easy question to answer; after all, who wouldn't be angry or hateful after being falsely accused, intentionally railroaded, then left to rot in prison while they laugh in your face and ignore all proof of your innocence? Hatred and anger would be a normal response from anyone in my position. But, believe it or not, I can honestly say I am not angry with Connie or anyone else. I am simply shocked, disgusted and deeply disturbed by their obvious lack of a moral conscience and ability to sleep at night knowing what they have done to me with their lies and corrupt acts. They know I am falsely accused and that everything I say, and all my evidence, is absolutely true. They don't deny one bit of it.

No matter how much abuse I suffer, I never hate anyone or wish anyone harm. Maybe something is wrong with me, because I cannot seem to help but care for every living thing. My entire life was spent reaching out to any creature needing my help, be it human beings or animals, and that's how I have always gotten my enjoyment in life. That's the way I have always been and they can't change that, no matter what they do to me.

Maybe that's why I was with Connie. She needed a lot of help and I thought I could help her and her son. And I tried very hard to do that, which she can never deny. Her biggest problem was alcohol but I could find no way of getting her away from it. I tried hard, even though her mother warned me to be "very careful" with trying to separate Connie from her beer. Connie used alcohol as an excuse for acting crazy, but without alcohol she would have no excuses so would have to face reality. But she can't face reality. Her entire life is just one big LIE. But no, I do not hate her, even after what she did to me. But I do want her to be held accountable, not necessarily by being locked up, but maybe with getting psychiatric care, which would help her. She is proving herself to be a cruel, heartless person who laughs at other people's suffering. How does she sleep at night?

And Judge Madden, DA Lipske, and Sheriff Bruneau -- are they mentally ill, or just evil? Good question! It is proven that they repeatedly act in corrupt ways in my case, and they all know I am innocent. Sheriff Bruneau even told me he knows something that would set me free, but won't say what it is! They are not humane or professional enough to do what's right here, yet, despite all this, I do not hate any of them. Though I pray for Connie and these others, I have not yet been able to change them. Nor have they been able to change me at all because I still have love in my heart -- and for that, I thank God.
